

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0028436

The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 27 Camino Cerrado RD/House, in the City of Santa Fe, in Santa Fe County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 35° 53' 55" North, Longitude 106° 01' 35" West. Discharges from the facility for the described activities are to Arroyo Destierro, thence to Pojoaque Creek, thence to Pojoaque River within the exterior boundaries of the Pueblo of Pojoaque, upstream from that portion of the river also designated as Segment No. 20.6.4.114 of the Upper Rio Grande Basin. The designated uses of the receiving stream waters(s) according to Pueblo of Pojoaque Water Quality Standards (PPWQS), Section IV.F, are irrigation, primary contact, marginal coldwater fisheries, groundwater recharge, livestock watering and wildlife habitat use. The designated uses for New Mexico are irrigation, livestock watering, wildlife habitat, marginal coldwater aquatic life, primary contact and warmwater aquatic life, and public water supply on the main stem Rio Grande.

Under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 6515, the applicant operates a mobile home site and a wastewater treatment plant with a design capacity of 0.02 million gallons per day (MGD) serving a population of approximately 69.

This is a renewal of a permit issued September 29, 2006, with an effective date of November 1, 2006, and an expiration date of October 31, 2010.

Changes from the previous permit are:

1. Fecal coliform bacteria limits have been eliminated.
2. *E. coli* bacteria limits have been added.
3. TSS and BOD minimum percent removal limits have been added.
4. TSS and BOD loading limits have been increased.
5. Design flow capacity has been corrected.
