

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0029149

The permittee is authorized to discharge from a facility is located at ½ mile southwest of Maxwell on Chico Road, in Colfax County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 36° 31' 55" North, Longitude 104° 32' 16" West. Discharges from the facility for treated sanitary wastewater to Canadian River are authorized according to New Mexico surface water quality standard 20.6.4.305 NMAC for Outfall 001. The designated beneficial uses of the receiving waters are irrigation, marginal warmwater aquatic life, livestock watering, wildlife habitat and primary contact.

Under the SIC Code 4952/ NAICS 221320, the applicant operates a privately owned wastewater sewerage system with a design flow capacity of 0.02 MGD serving 300 people. This is a renewal of a permit previously issued May 25, 2007, with an effective date of June 1, 2007, and an expiration date of May 31, 2012.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
