

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0029319

The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 583 Road 6100, Kirtland, San Juan County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 36° 43' 23" N; Longitude 108° 22' 01" W. Discharges from the facility for the described activities are to the San Juan River, State of New Mexico Segment No.20.6.4.401 of the San Juan River Basin. The known uses of the receiving water are public and industrial water supply, irrigation, livestock watering, wildlife habitat, primary contact, marginal coldwater aquatic life and warmwater aquatic life.

Under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 4952, the applicant operates a Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) with a design capacity of 0.05 million gallons per day (MGD).

This is a renewal of a permit issued January 30, 2006, with an effective date of March 1, 2006, and an expiration date of February 28, 2011.

Changes from the previous permit are:

- A. FCB limits have been eliminated.
- B. Monthly average waste load limit for *E. coli* has been added
- C. Increase monitoring frequency for flow
- D. Increase monitoring frequency for TRC
- E. Increase monitoring frequency for pH
- F. Add percent (minimum) removal for BOD and TSS

State Certification

The notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
