

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0030236

The permittee is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 506 South D.L. Ingram Blvd, approximately 8 miles west of Clovis, NM, and 12 miles north of Portales, NM in Curry County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 34° 23' 15" North, Longitude 103° 18' 00" West and Outfall 002 located at Latitude 34° 24' 00" North, Longitude 103° 19' 33" West. Discharges from the facility for the described activities are to North Playa Lake and Golf Course Pond. The designated beneficial uses of the receiving waters are warmwater aquatic life, livestock watering, wildlife habitat, and primary contact.

Under the SIC Code 4952, the applicant operates a federally owned wastewater treatment plant with a design flow capacity of 0.75 million gallons per day serving 6,200 people. This is a renewal of a permit previously issued February 27, 2006, with an effective date of April 1, 2006, and an expiration date of March 31, 2011.

#### State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
