

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0030376

The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 725 Electric Ave. SE, Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 35° 16' 00" North, Longitude 106° 38' 30" West. Discharges from the facility for the described activities are an unlined, non-classified, otherwise ephemeral, and unnamed dry arroyo thence to AMAFCA South Diversion Channel, thence to the Rio Grande River in segment number 20.6.4.105 of the Rio Grand Basin in direct response to a precipitation event. The known uses of the receiving water(s) are livestock watering, wildlife habitat, secondary contact, primary contact recreation and warmwater aquatic life.

Under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 4911, the applicant operates a electric-power generating plant with a design capacity of 0.0458 million gallons per day (MGD).

This is a renewal of a permit issued June 30, 2005, with an effective date of August 1, 2005, and an expiration date of July 31, 2009.

Changes from the previous permit are:

- A. TSS limits have been added.
- B. WET monitoring requirements added.
- C. Hardness monitoring added.
- D. Technology-based limit for chromium replaced with prohibition clause for chromium.
- E. Prohibition clause for zinc added.
