

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0031097

The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located at Highway 518 and ranger Drive, Mora, Mora County, New Mexico, from Outfall 001 located at Latitude 35° 58' 34.1" North, Longitude 105° 19' 59.5" West. Discharges from the facility for the described activities are to the Mora River, in Waterbody Segment No. 20.6.4.309 of the Canadian River Basin. The designated beneficial uses of the receiving waters are domestic water supply, irrigation, high quality coldwater aquatic life, livestock watering, wildlife habitat, and primary contact.

Under the Standard Industrial Classification Code 8211, the facility is a public school and the project is to dewater groundwater from athletic fields during wet parts of the year.

This is a first-time permit.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification. The purpose of such certification is to reasonably ensure that the permitted activities will be conducted in a manner that will comply with applicable New Mexico water quality standards, including the antidegradation policy, and the statewide water quality management plan. The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
