The permit requires CAFO owners/operators seeking permit coverage to submit a notice of intent (NOI) and nutrient management plan (NMP) to EPA. The NOI, NMP, and draft terms of the NMP to be incorporated into the permit will be made available for a 30-day public review and comment period.
