

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. TX0127566

The facility is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 1500 Lamar Street, Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, to a constructed wetland, thence the Intracoastal Waterway, thence the Gulf of Mexico, of the Brazos River Tidal of the Brazos River Basin, Water Body Segment Code No. 1201. The designated beneficial uses of Water Body Segment Code No. 2310 are contact recreation and high aquatic life.

Under the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code No. 4922, the applicant operates a commercial natural gas facility receiving liquefied natural gas (LNG) (at minus 260° F), and changing its state to natural gas (NG) (at plus 65° F) for delivery into the interstate pipeline system.

This is a reissuance of a permit issued July 11, 2008, with an effective date of August 1, 2008, and an expiration date of July 31, 2013.

Changes from the previous permit are as follows:

1. The permit establishes more stringent pH requirements.
