The facility is a new discharger located in Harris County, Houston, Texas. The facility commences approximately 0.75 miles southeast of the intersection of Beltway 8 and State Highway 3 and ends approximately two miles southeast of the intersection of Interstate 10 and Beltway 8. EPA proposes that this permit be issued. A Statement of Basis is available, and describes the rationale for permit conditions. Under the SIC code 4612, Crude Petroleum Pipelines, the applicant provides transportation services for crude oil distribution utilities, marketers, producers, industrial end users and other shippers.
