You are invited to submit a presentation proposal for the 15th Annual Stormwater Conference to be held June 16-21, 2013, in New Orleans, Louisiana. - BMP Technology (Maintenance and effectiveness of BMP's and evaluation measures)**
- Public Education and Outreach**
- Local Ordinances, Enforcement and Legal**

Presentation Criteria

Presentation(s) are selected based on the following criteria:

- Thoroughness of the subject matter and proposal**
- Originality of materials**
- Quality of learning objectives**
- Level of content and method of diverse teaching styles**
- Quality of takeaway tools offered to all conference registrants**
- Appeal to a diverse and broad spectrum of attendees**

NOTE: Only educational content should be submitted for consideration. No abstracts will be accepted if they include marketing material or specific product content. You will **NOT** receive a copy of your submission. Identify the level of technical content of your presentation (basic, intermediate or advanced)

No presentation abstracts will be accepted after March 1, 2013

Include the following information:

- Course Title
- Course Instructor(s): Name, email, phone number
- List 3 Learning Objectives
- Basic Course content or outline, conclusions, and support material: (not over 400 words)
- Brief personal biography

Presentations should not exceed 50 minutes (including time for introductions and evaluations).

If your presentation exceeds one hour, note this time on your proposal.

This is a green conference, so lengthy handouts are discouraged. Presenters are encouraged to provide electronic copies of their presentation materials in advance so that these materials can be posted on the conference website, and downloaded by those registering for the conference.
