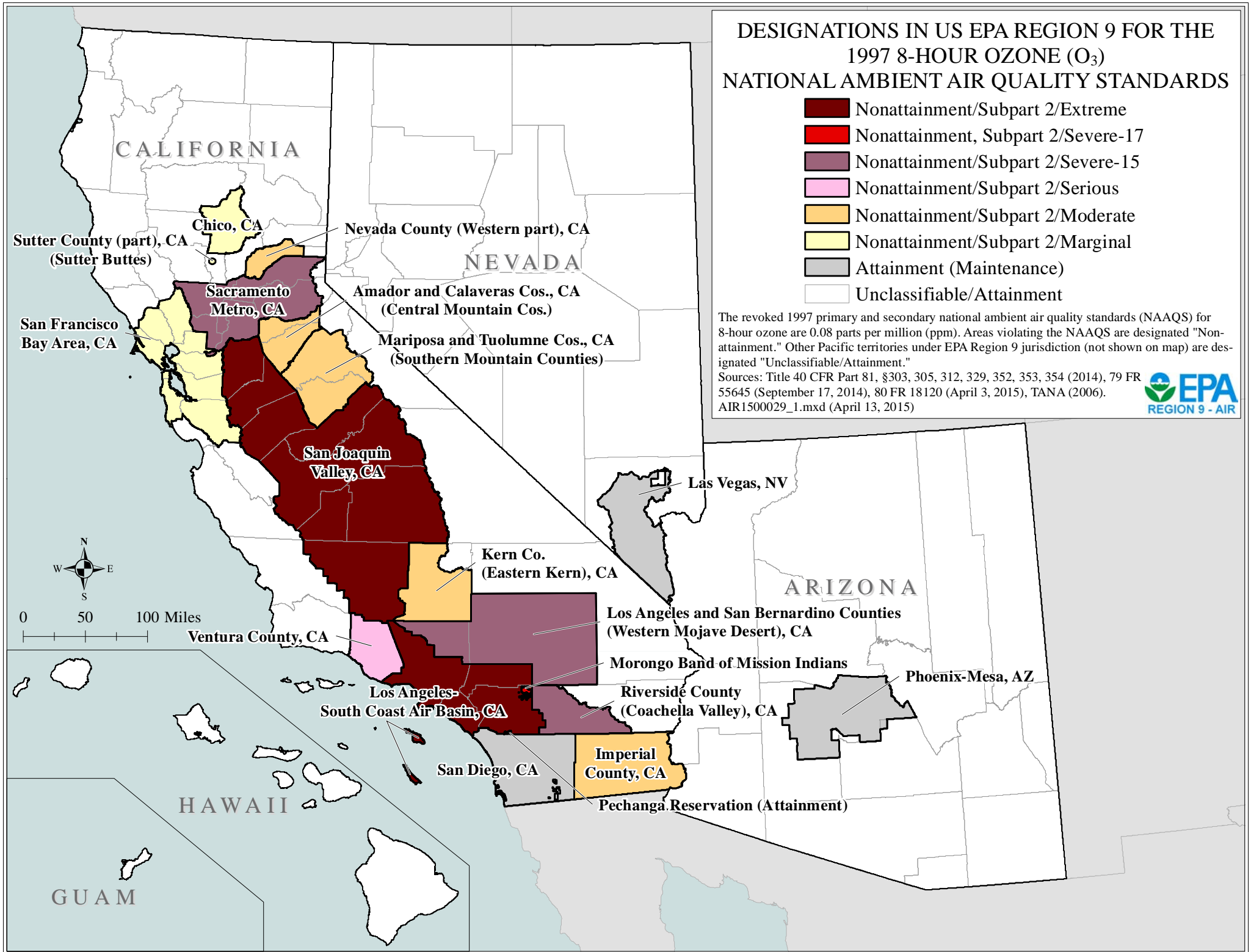


# DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 1997 8-HOUR OZONE (O<sub>3</sub>) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

- Nonattainment/Subpart 2/Extreme
- Nonattainment, Subpart 2/Severe-17
- Nonattainment/Subpart 2/Severe-15
- Nonattainment/Subpart 2/Serious
- Nonattainment/Subpart 2/Moderate
- Nonattainment/Subpart 2/Marginal
- Attainment (Maintenance)
- Unclassifiable/Attainment

The revoked 1997 primary and secondary national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for 8-hour ozone are 0.08 parts per million (ppm). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment." Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment."
