

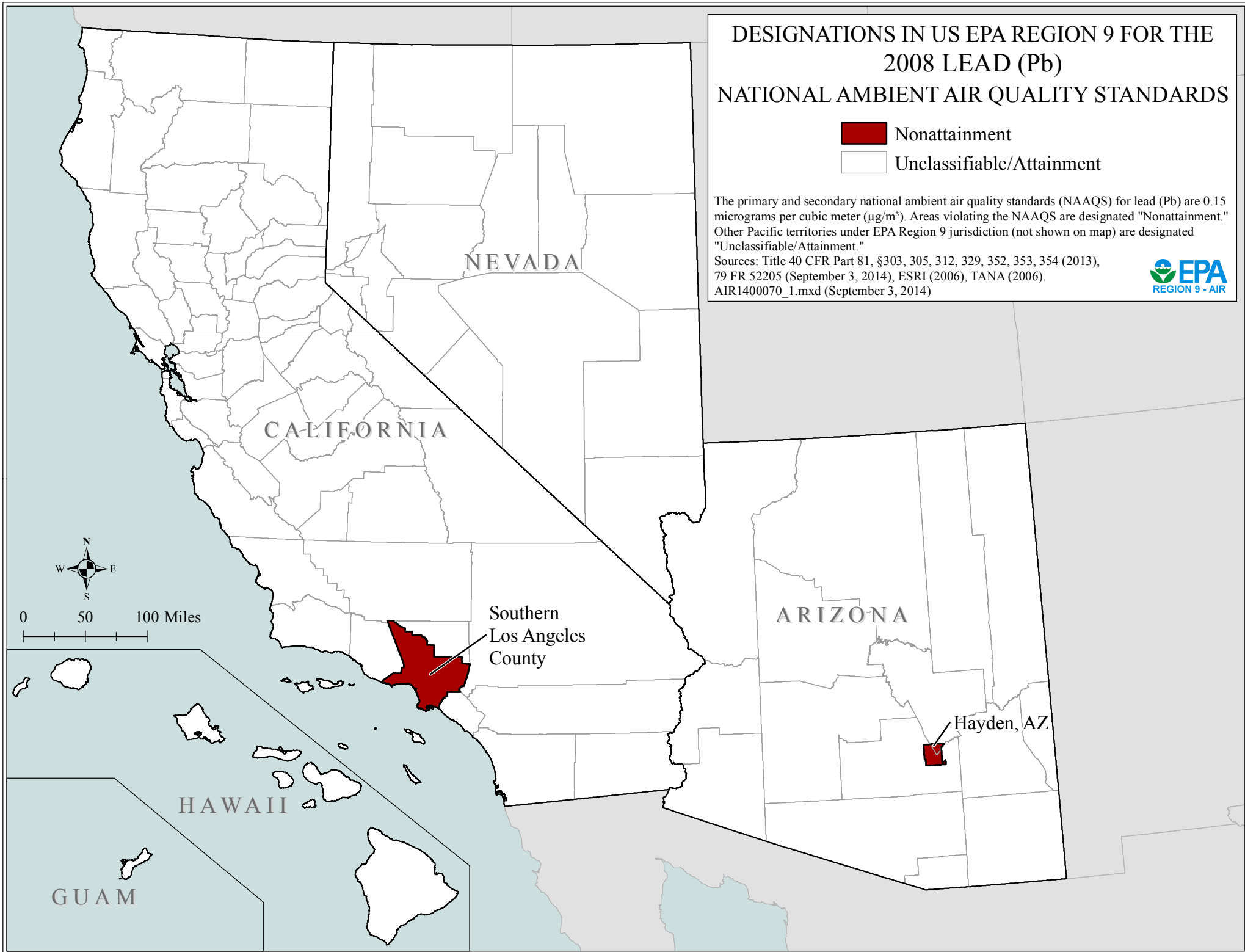


DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 2008 LEAD (Pb) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

-  Nonattainment
-  Unclassifiable/Attainment

The primary and secondary national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for lead (Pb) are 0.15 micrograms per cubic meter ($\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment." Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment."
