

DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE 1987 24-HOUR PARTICULATE MATTER (PM₁₀) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS (NAAQS)

- Nonattainment/Serious
- Nonattainment/Moderate
- Attainment (Maintenance area)
- Unclassifiable
- State boundary or coastline
- County boundary

The 1987 primary and secondary 24-hour NAAQS for particulate matter less than 10 micrometers in diameter (PM₁₀) are 150 micrograms per cubic meter (µg/m³). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment", and are classified based on the number of days the area is estimated to have exceeded the NAAQS over a consecutive three-year period. All Pacific territories under U.S. jurisdiction not shown on this map are designated "Unclassifiable".
