

DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE PRIMARY 2015 8-HOUR OZONE (8-hour O₃) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS (NAAQS)

- Nonattainment/Extreme
- Nonattainment/Severe-15
- Nonattainment/Serious
- Nonattainment/Moderate
- State boundary or coastline
- County boundary
- Nonattainment/Marginal
- Nonattainment/Marginal (Rural Transport)

The 2015 primary and secondary 8-hour O₃ NAAQS is 0.070 parts per million (ppm). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment", and are classified based on the severity of their ozone levels (as determined based on the area's "design value," which represents air quality in the area for the most recent three years). All Pacific territories under U.S. jurisdiction not shown on this map are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment". The *Sutter County (part), CA (Sutter Buttes)* nonattainment area is representational on this map; true boundaries are not shown due to scale.
