Under the DTSC Hazardous Waste Permit, Waste Management must always monitor for chemical releases to air, soil vapor, surface water, and groundwater, at the Kettleman Hills Facility. The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board and the US Environmental Protection Agency work with DTSC to administer these monitoring programs.
