SUMMARY OF COMMUNICATION:

Source has been out of compliance and the State of NC has been looking for way to

get them into compliance. One idea has been to rearrange the emission configuration

and to do a bubble. The source is in complex terrain. The State want to try to work out a Level II bubble. However, apparently there is an emission increase involved.

Issue: Can they do a Level II Bubble?

C/H Comment: With an emission increase and its location in Complex terrain, they

probably will need to do a Level III bubble, which is really almost like a SIP revision.

Issue: Do they need to do PM10 as well as TSP?

Discussion: C/H agreed with Region IV that they probably need to include PM10,
but
this is a bit out of our expertise and Region IV probably should check with
their
SIP people.
