SUBJECT: Ketchikan Pulp Company Use of ISC Model Codes

In response to the requirements of a consent decree, the Ketchikan Pulp Company (KPC) must submit air modeling results to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation by June 10, 1988. As part of that modeling analysis, KPC must use the ISC model. Because the current versions of ISC (ISCST - 87338, ISCLT - 87352) in UNAMAP Version 6, Change 3 contain errors, and because of the court-ordered time constraints, I have directed KPC to use the formerly approved versions of ISC (ISCST - 86322, ISCLT - 86329) in UNAMAP Version 6, Change 2.

I have also made the Company aware that you will be providing corrections for the errors in the current ISC codes very soon, within a few weeks. They understand that any modeling performed after the corrections are generally available will require the use of the new ISC codes.

I hereby request your concurrence with my recommendations to KPC.
