NOTE TO DEAN WILSON

SUBJECT: Comments on El Paso/Juarez Modeling Protocol

1. The CAA Amendments will likely require a second SIP submission for those areas, such as El Paso, that will not show attainment with their initial SIP submittal. This modeling will likely form the basis for this second SIP submittal.
2. It appears from prior observation of Juarez that area sources (unpaved roads, motor vehicles, and open burning for incineration, cooking and heat) will be major contributors to PM-10 transported into the U.S. Substantial effort should be made to ensure a quality inventory of these emissions.
3. Receptor models will be extremely useful in evaluating/refining the Juarez emission inventory for PM-10, CO, and possibly VOC's.
