SUBJECT: Review of the Utah PM-10 Draft SIP

We have received documentation from the State of Utah on their draft PM-10 SIP for Utah County and Magna. (Magna is in Salt Lake County, but is being separated from the Salt Lake County SIP since the Magna PM-10 problem is site specific; Kennecott is the contributing source.)

We have also received the Geneva Steel analyses, emission inventory, etc. The Geneva source profile (as obtained from the Geneva stack test (performed by Geneva's consultant, John Cooper)) was used by Utah to refine the State's CMB analyses for Utah County.

In keeping with the matrix of technical assistance, please review the attached documents. Region VIII has performed preliminary analysis of these documents; the "lead" individuals identified in the matrix are ready to discuss these comments with you. We request written comments by August 14, 1989. The comments should be sent to the "lead" Region VIII individual or myself. Region VIII will incorporate all comments to the State shortly thereafter. The public hearing is scheduled for September 5, 6, and 7, 1989. Utah, however, would appreciate any comments as soon as possible. Early comments would help the State prepare to address the issues at the hearing.
