STORET is an up and coming water quality data sharing tool in the State of Colorado with successful implementations by organizations such as Metro Wastewater Reclamation District, South Platte Coalition of Urban Regulated Entities, and the Colorado River Watch Network. Plans for a future state wide STORET is being spearheaded by the Colorado Water Quality Monitoring Council (CWQMC). The CWQMC is planning to utilize STORET and available internet based tools such as Web SIM and the ArcIMS mapping application developed by region 10 to upload and disseminate 319 grant data and other water quality data being collected throughout Colorado. In addition they intend to set up an out-reach program, develop user documentation and user support for inexperienced STORET users needing to upload 319 grant data or wishing to upload water quality data in general.
