

## *The Tribal Information Management System*

The Tribal Information Management System (TIMS) is a powerful Web-based Geographic Information System tool that provides a wide range of Federal information about environmental conditions and features for Indian Country. This application supports the U.S. EPA National Indian Program by geographically enabling STORET section 106 water monitoring data. Through TIMS, users can visualize the monitoring sites within a particular Tribal boundary.

The TIMS architecture is based on Oracle Spatial and Environmental Systems Research ArcSDA, with and EnviroMapper interface based on ArcIMS. The application is provided by the U.S. EPA American Indian Environmental Office through the Indian Country Baseline Assessment Project.
