# 2008 NEI – Progress to Date

- Design, development and deployment of the new Emission Inventory System (EIS) completed for 2008 NEI
- 2008 Data Successfully Submitted to EIS by:
  - 47 States
  - 18 Locals
  - 14 Tribes
- EPA Developed Data and Submitted to EIS for:
  - EGUs
  - Onroad Mobile
  - Nonroad Mobile
  - Airports
  - Various Nonpoint Categories
  - Commercial Marine
  - Locomotives
  - Fires
- Creation of a draft 2008 NEI completed in July, 2008.

# 2008 NEI – Remaining Milestones

- November 1, 2010 – Submission window closes for 2008 NEI v1
- November – December 2010 – Final QA and Selection for 2008 NEI v1
- January 2011 – Public release of 2008 NEI v1
- January 2011 – New public web site for emissions data opens
- January 2011 – Summer 2011 – Development of 2008 NEI v2
  - Stay tuned for more details

# Beyond the 2008 NEI

- Implementation of Air Emission Reporting Requirements (AERR) for 2009 Inventory
  - Point source reporting threshold changes to be consistent with Title V threshold
  - State/local/tribal data due to EPA within 12 months of the end of the inventory Year
- Integration of NEI with Other OAQPS Data Collection Activities
  - Information Collection Requests (ICRs) that support stationary source rules
  - National Air Toxics Assessment (NATA)
