• Once the data is entered correctly, if the ERT does not seem to be responding, close the section you are working in. Then reopen that tab and see if the data are now correctly displayed. If the blank table still exists, double check the point data to make sure the changes are reflected in the data set. If everything is good and the ERT is still showing the blank table, the ERT may need to restart. Save the file (it should automatically save but it is a good precaution before closing and reopening the file), then close the ERT. This basically allows the program to refresh. Reopening your project data set should now reveal the data as you expect it to be displayed.
