Attached are our definitive comments on the major problem areas in the draft background information document (BID) and proposed standard for controlling solvent emissions to the atmosphere from new and modified solvent spun synthetic fiber manufacturing facilities. These comments generally address matters relating to dry spun acrylic fiber production, but some overall issues are considered as well. These items were discussed in much more detail with representatives from EPA and Pacific Environmental Services, Inc. earlier today.

This information is transmitted to EPA and Pacific Environmental Services, Inc. under a claim of confidentiality in all respects, except for actual atmospheric emission data, which, by law, cannot be claimed as confidential.

It is our hope that this submission of information will result in a more technically sound BID with respect to dry spun acrylic fiber production. We offer our continued assistance in achieving that goal.


