In response to your request, the Model Clearinghouse has reviewed the circumstances involved in S. D. Warren's need for immediate application of the ISC model in conjunction with its revised PSD permit application. We agree that fairness to the source suggests that the company be allowed to perform and complete their modeling in an expedient fashion.

Accordingly, we are willing, in this case, to allow the use of the UNAMAP6, Change 2 version of ISC, which was in effect prior to January 6, 1988. As you are aware, the corrections to the ISC model code are expected to be completed in a short time, i.e., in a few weeks. Thus you should carefully monitor progress on the modeling for S. D. Warren in the interim. If, by the time our corrections have been released, the modeling for this source is not substantially complete, the company should be required to complete the modeling according to the guidance in effect at that time.

Also, as you have indicated in your memorandum, S. D. Warren should be made aware that if for any reason there is a need to reanalyze the ambient air quality impact in the future, the version of ISC current at that time will be required in the model application.
