

AQS Data Mart — what is it?

- It's a database with all the data (since 1980) from AQS in it
 - Copied from AQS to keep AQS fast for loading
 - 1.72 Billion raw and NAAQS average values (as of 7/21/08)
 - Commensurate daily and annual summaries
- Targeted for application builders and health researchers
- It's on the "public" side of the EPA firewall
 - To keep AQS safe
- It allows for applications to be connected to it
 - Like Google Earth!

Connected Applications

- AQS Data Mart Direct Interface (750/mo)
- AirCompare (8,000/mo)
- KML Files (1,800 in first 3 weeks of KML)
- RSIG (can't yet track)
- EPHT (EPA → CDC project) (can't yet track)
- AirNow + VIEWS exchange (in progress)*
- AirExplorer (planned)
- Exchange Network (planned)

 - 2200+ entries
 - Pretty dry and some areas need improvement
 - ~ 25 downloads per month this year
