SUBJECT: Changes in Parameter Codes Used to Report PM2.5 Continuous Monitor and Speciation Sampler Data to AQS

The attached technical note provides details on updated procedures for reporting PM2.5 continuous monitor and speciation sampler mass data to AQS. These procedures are part of an effort to store data so that analysts can better understand their primary purpose and utility to support other data objectives. OAQPS will notify the national laboratory services contractor for speciation. In cases where a State laboratory performs this work or contracts it out, the monitoring agency should notify the laboratory of these new procedures.
