Subject Populating Site Standard Coordination Fields

AQS User,

On August 11, 2007, AQS software was installed for two upgrades. The release notes for this install dated August 8, 2007 from Chuck Isbell discussed the implementation. This email is in reference to the "Enhancement to the Site Registration Process".

The original release notes indicated that a process for populating these standard coordinates would be distributed. The attachment, Procedure to populate Standard Coordinates.doc, is that process.

As discussed in the attachment, the standard coordinates can be populated by using Maintain Site or Batch Load. The attached process includes a cook book process for using output from Discoverer to create transactions for input to the Batch Load. Also attached is an Excel file, ST01site geo spatial.xls, created by Discoverer as an example. This file can be used as a starting point to test the cook book process to convert it into the batch transaction file.

Please use this process to populate standard coordinates as time permits. Please contact me if you have questions concerning this process.
