# Air Toxics Archival Database

- **EPA updating Ambient Monitoring Archive (AMA)**
  - The archive will cover measurements from as early as 1973 to 2010.
  - The AMA for HAPs currently houses over 26 million data records from nearly 2,500 monitoring sites
  - The data have been split by state
  - Zipped Microsoft Access databases
