Subject: URG3000N Compact Flash Cards

I will continue to use this forum to communicate issues and information relevant to the implementation of the URG3000N for the Phase 1 sites. Here is a note on compact flash card readers.

I have had a few inquiries regarding the compact flash cards in the URG3000N samplers. The cards can be read by the state agency/operators to view the relevant data collection information for QA, troubleshooting and other purposes. The cards can be read with a compact flash card reader. No special software is required and the files can be viewed in any text editor (e.g., Notepad). Card readers range from \$15 to \$25 and come in various configurations. I have included some web site links for the most common (my opinion) readers...USB and PCMCIA. Others are available. Of course, you can buy these anywhere, but I thought a few web sites as examples would help show you what can be procured. Please note that web sites change frequently and the sites below may not be active for long periods of time after this note.
