#### Green Facility:

The Doubletree Hotel & Executive Meeting Center is the first full-service, Green Seal certified hotel in Oregon, the first hotel in Portland to be awarded the Blue Works designation by the Office of Sustainable Development and is Portland's first adopter of the "Portland Composts!" program. The hotel practices include buying local and buying recycled and they have created a "Green Team" of hotel staff to focus specifically on identifying and enhancing their sustainable efforts.

#### Ground

#### Transportation:

**Taxi:** Taxi fare from Portland International Airport to the Doubletree Hotel Portland – Lloyd Center hotel is approximately \$20 one-way. The pick up area for taxis is located in the center section of the airports terminal's lower roadway on the baggage claim and departure level.

### Transportation:

***MAX Rail from the Airport:*** Board MAX Red Line to City Center and & Beaverton. Get off at the Lloyd Center/ NE 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue MAX Station. Exit the station and turn right towards Multnomah Street. The walk from the station to the hotel is less than a block. The one-way fare is \$2.05. Service runs every 15 minutes seven days a week between 4:30 a.m. and 11:30 p.m.

***MAX Rail Around Portland:*** Ask the hotel concierge for a light rail brochure with schedules and stops for the “free” light rail from the Doubletree Hotel to Downtown Portland, which can take you to a wide variety of dining, shopping, cultural and entertainment options.

### Driving Directions:

#### ***From Portland International Airport:***

Follow Airport way to I-205 South. Then take I-84 West. Go approximately 5 miles to exit 1 - Lloyd Boulevard. Go to the second light off of the exit and take a right. Go 1 and 1/2 blocks and the Hotel and the Lloyd Center will be on the left.

#### ***From East:***

Take Interstate I-84 W/US-30 W towards Portland. Take the Lloyd Center exit – Exit 1. Keep right at the fork to go onto NE 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Then turn left on to NE Multnomah Street. Hotel will be on the left.

#### ***From North:***

Take I-5 South to the Rose Quarter – City Center exit 302A. Take the ramp toward Rose Quarter and turn a slight right onto North Vancouver Avenue. North Vancouver Avenue becomes North Wheeler Avenue. Go about half a mile and turn left onto NE Multnomah Street. The hotel will be on the left.

#### ***From South:***

Take I-5 South to the Rose Quarter – Broadway exit 302A. Turn right onto NE Weidler Street. Then take a right onto NE 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and then a left onto NE Multnomah Street. The hotel will be on the left.

**Airport Information:** The Portland International Airport is approximately 10.5 miles from the hotel and the drive takes about 20-30 minutes, depending upon the time of day and traffic.

**Parking:** Parking is available at the Doubletree Hotel Portland-Lloyd Center. The Doubletree Hotel Executive Meeting Center Portland Lloyd ~ Center would like to extend a discounted parking rate of \$9.00 for all overnight guests with in/out privileges and \$3.00 for all daytime guests.

**Onsite Check in:** Onsite check in will take place each day, one hour before sessions start, outside the meeting room. Please stop by to pick up your nametag and handout materials.

**Area Attractions:** Oregon’s largest shopping mall “Lloyd Center” is across the street from the Doubletree and offers over 200 shops, 30 restaurants and 18 movie theaters. Portland has NO SALES TAX!

The downtown is small and personable. Half-size city blocks and plentiful public art make Portland the ideal city to explore on foot. *Walking* magazine ranked Portland one of “America’s Best Walking Towns” in 1998. Vibrant neighborhoods, popular shopping districts and inviting parks keep Portland’s downtown lively, even when you might least expect it to be - evenings and weekends. Portland’s Saturday Market is the largest continuously operating open craft market in the United States.

If you are arriving early or staying after the conference, natural beauty is within a 1-hour drive to Multnomah Falls, Mt. Hood, the Oregon Coast, and the Columbia River Gorge.
